### **EVERY MOTHER AND EVERY CHILD COUNTS: TWO INCUBATORS DONATED TO THE OWENDO UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL (CHUO)**

Since it opened to the public in March 2016, 246 babies were born at CHUO; 48 of them had to be placed in incubators, and 4 were referred to another hospital for lack of space.
